State Rep call Quinn state of state a look at past, not future

SPRINGFIELD—As a freshman legislator listening to his first State of the State address from the floor of the Illinois House, State Rep. Josh Harms (R-Watseka) wanted to see a renewed commitment to growing Illinois' economy, but was instead treated to a speech more focused on the past than the future.

"Governor Quinn had a real opportunity to wipe the slate clean and come out with an aggressive jobs and economic policy here," said Harms. "What we received was a divisive look back rather than a vision forward.

"Illinois has over 210,000 unpaid bills totaling over \$9 billion dollars. We have the worst budget deficit in the nation. Since 2008, Illinois has lost the third most jobs in the country, and our unemployment rate is well above the national average at 8.9%. The last thing Governor Ouinn should be discussing is gun control and gay mar-

Harms, a former teacher who was sworn into office i January, will serve on a range of committees during the upcoming legislative session including the Higher Education Appropriations, Economic Development, Cities and Villages, Business Occupational Licenses Public Safety: Police and Fire in addition to his requested Agricultural and Conservation Committee.


