

#### Principal outlines safety plan

Dear Parents and Families of the Communities served in the Hoopeston Area CUSD #11:

Since the past two months of our nation dealing with the unimaginable act of violence on innocent lives at the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Conn., many educators and communities have felt the grief and concern over these types of acts upon our school staff and students. This incident has brought on yet another increase in our concerns as a nation regarding the increase of school violence that we all share daily.

Therefore, I felt it necessary to share with you the steps taken annually regarding our High School and District Crisis Management Plans, required for the Illinois State Board of Education. Please note that the general procedures and steps listed below are used to address our #1 priority, the safety of our students and staff of the Hoopeston Area CUSD #11.

May/June: The district administrative team (principals, superintendent, buildings and grounds) meet with the Hoopeston Police Department to go over any new information regarding school safety as well as an assessment of the buildings/ grounds for our Crisis Management Plan. Following this meeting, we will begin any updates and/ or revisions to our plan so that we can have a copy of it ready for print prior to the school year beginning. This document is 30 pages long and covers several crisis related topics, along with names and phone numbers for the Crisis Response Team.

August: The updated/ revised Crisis Management Plan is talked about at our administrative meeting with the principals and then it is shared during the first two days of teacher institute with the teachers and staff. This plan is provided to the teachers and staff as they will escort students to the "Reunification"

Site" in the event that we would need to evacuate students for safety.

September to May: Several Illinois State Board of Education required drills are planned throughout the school year such as fire, tornado, bus evacuation and lock down. Along with this, middle/high school teachers and staff coordinate training together.

Communication: This plan also indicates that the media communication will be handled by the dstrict spokesperson which is the superintendent. The building principal will be responsible for notifying parents via the school messenger system as soon as possible with
