Changes coming as HPL moving to new circulation system

Hoopeston Public Library will soon move to a new online card catalog and circulation system. Polaris will help us be more efficient in searching for items, requesting items and materials circulation.

We are migrating to Polaris from our current online system with the help of the Illinois Heartland Library System, which took the place of Lincoln Trail Libraries System. Illinois Heartland Library System covers 28,141 square miles and serves a population of 2,248,634. There are 585 member libraries.


There will be many benefits to our patrons with the new system. However, during the transition time, there are things patrons need to know.

Please print a list of your current requests for your records. If you do not have the ability to print your request list, call the circulation desk for help before March




