Board gets look at new slogan, vision, mission statements

Expect more!

That slogan is expected to be approved next month by Hoopeston Area School Board, after it was introduced at Thursday's board meeting.

In presenting the slogan to the board, Superintendent Hank Hornbeck said "we should always expect more of our students and of each other."

The slogan, along with new vision and mission statements, are expected to be approved in May. The vision statement states that the district's vision is to expect more by building relationships with families and communities; preparing students for success in college, ca-

reer and life; and ensuring students have equitable access to excellence throughout the district.

The mission statement states that, in cooperation with families and communities, the district will engage students in a rigorous curriculum that expects academic and behavioral excellence.

- Approved resignations from Kevin Root as freshman boys' basketball coach and Dulsey Young, fifth grade girls basketball coach.
- Honorably dismissed Cayla Knight as middle school personal aide, at the end of the school year.
- Hired Beth Schafer and Ashley Blotcky, both second grade teachers.
- Approved Linda Sheppard's intent to retire as Honeywell principal at the end of the 2014-15 year.
- Hired Janet Elliott as a Maple personal aide for the rest of the year.
- Approved hiring Russell Leigh & Associates for the annual audit at a cost not to exceed \$6,000.
