



Hoopeston man killed in two-vehicle accident Wednesday

A 30-year-old Hoopeston man was pronounced dead at the scene of a two-vehicle accident Wednesday.

Elizandro Solis Jr. was pronounced dead at 2:18 p.m. Wednesday, according a release from Vermilion County Coroner Peggy Johnson.

An autopsy was scheduled for Thursday afternoon.

The accident occurred at 1:53 p.m. Wednesday about two miles west of Hoopeston on Route 9, three-tenths of a mile east of County Road 1300 East, said Captain Dennis Wood of the Vermilion County Sheriff's Depart-

Wood said Mr. Solis, in a 2000 Volkswagen, was eastbound and Ronnie Hair, 52, of Gridley, was westbound in a 2001 Kenworth semi tractor trailer, when Mr.

Solis entered Hair's lane and the two struck head on.

Wood said a witness told police that she was eastbound and had passed a vehicle and that looking in her rearview mirror, she saw Mr. Solis in the westbound lane, apparently attempting to pass the same vehicle she had passed.

Hair's semi ignited after the collision and was destroved by fire. He was taken to Carle Foundation Hospital by Hoopeston Ambulance.

Hoopeston Fire Department was on the scene for several hours, dealing with the accident and fire, then washing fuel from the scene.

The accident is still under investigation by the sheriff's department and coroner's office.
