## HALO's 'Smiling Faces Dental Days' coming to Hoopeston

DANVILLE—HALO Project, a Healthy Community Initiative Sponsored by Presence United Samaritans Medical Center's Foundation, in partnership with Colgate-Bright Smiles Bright Futures and Orland Park Dental Services, will host "Smiling Faces Dental Days" on June 27 & 28.

Children ages three to 18 will receive a free dental screening as well as a goody bag with dental supplies to use for proper oral hygiene at home. Parents/ guardians must accompany children.

The Colgate-Bright Smiles Bright Futures Dental Van will be at McFerren Park in Hoopeston from 9:30-11:30 a.m. June 27.

The van will also be available from 1-4 p.m. June 27 at Fair Oaks Housing Complex, Danville; and from 9:30-11:30 a.m. June 28 at St. Mary's Church, Westville and 1-4 p.m. June 28 at Vermilion Garden Apartments.

Walk-up Registrations Saturdays, June 22 and July 6, 10 am to 12 pm at the Danville complex. Hoopeston does not hold walk up registration. All sign ups must go through Danville's website, or mail in forms are available.

Late registrations 7/14-7/21 will include a \$15 late fee and players placed on a waiting list pending spot availability.

Children and their parent/guardian from all cities and towns in Vermilion County are welcome at any of the four sites. Services are provided on a "first come first served" basis.

The dental screening satisfies all Vermilion County school districts' dental screening requirement for children in kindergarten, second, and sixth grades. Forms will be completed and given to the parent/guardian at the time of the screening.

Colgate-Bright Smiles Bright Futures will provide the dental van, supplies, and goody bags, while Orland Park Dental Services will provide the dentist and hygienist who will be completing the dental screenings.

"Dental health is directly related to other overall health, and there is now medical proof that gum disease is directly linked to developing cardiovascular disease," said Kathy Richard, HALO Project director. "It is extremely important that children receive appropriate dental care and that they are taught how to properly take care of their teeth now in order to avoid the risk of disease later in life."

Many children and their families in Vermilion County do not have access to or cannot afford dental care. Many families admit to not having enough dental supplies for each member of their family to practice healthy oral hygiene.

"If you know of family, friends, church members, acquaintances, coworkers, or neighbors who do not have transportation to one of the dental van sites, please be a good Samaritan and provide transportation for them," added Richard.

If children needing screenings are unavailable to attend one of the dates, local dentists will provide screenings at the Children's Health Safety & Activity Fair on September 7 from 10 am to 2 pm at the Village Mall in
