DACC moving ahead with plans for Hoopeston satellite

Danville Area Community College officials are moving ahead with plans for a satellite campus in Hoopeston.

DACC has listed openings for a director and office assistant for the site.

According to the job posting, the director will be responsible for development and management of the site and will provide leadership for staff concerning the community college operations and processes. The position is listed at 40 hours per week.

The assistant will work 25 hours per week and will be responsible for all secretarial duties for all areas of the college and coordination, scheduling and monitoring of all center activities.
