## Hoopeston Area grad attends West Virginia science camp

CHARLESTON, WV—Michelle Seat, of Hoopeston Area High School, represented Illinois as a delegate to the 2013 National Youth Science Camp® (NYSC). Seat joined 121 other top high school graduates representing the United States and nine other countries at the prestigious four-week program, now in its 50th year. NYSC, located in the Monongahela National Forest in West Virginia, integrates scientific programming with opportunities for delegates to explore music, art, and the outdoors. Each year, delegates are able to attend lectures and directed studies led by top scientists and professors from

all over the country. This year's lecture topics included: cancer research, genomic medicine, radio astronomy, and energy sustainability. Throughout camp, the directed study program allowed delegates to have extensive hands-on experience in specific fields of individual interest. Delegates had the opportunity to dissect a pig's heart, discuss bioethics, construct robots, and study cybersecurity measures.

In addition to learning about groundbreaking scientific research, delegates explored their natural surroundings through an outdoor program consisting of hiking, caving, mountain biking, and rock climbing. Overnight backpacking trips provided delegates an opportunity to bond and appreciate the simplicity of nature. Delegates also chose from seminars ranging from Ultimate Frisbee and swing dancing to discussions of philosophy, travel, religion, and culture. Seat said, "NYSC has changed me in the sense that it has stretched my abilities and has made me a more well-rounded person. I have learned a lot and now feel more comfortable with different subject areas." Seat added, "NYSC has prepared me for college and my future because it has exposed me to many different aspects of science. It has also encouraged me to do what
