Clock starts next Tuesday on city water tank refurb project

The clock on the project to update Hoopeston's aerial and ground storage tanks officially will start ticking Tuesday.

Officials of Leander Construction, of Canton, signed construction documents and are expected to attend a pre-construction meeting Tuesday, said Mike Streff, of Foth Infrastructure and Environment, said at Tuesday night's Hoopeston City Council meeting.


That meeting, which will be held at 2:30 p.m. and is open to the public, starts the clock on the project, which must be "substantially completed" within 488 days, Streff said, adding work should be done by January 25, 2015. Final payment for work must be made by 730 days from Tuesday, or September 24, 2015, he said.

The project will include cleaning out the inside and outside of the tanks, which will then be painted and decorated with Hoopeston and a rendition of Jerky, the school mascot.

Hoopeston received a \$2,536,692 EPA loan to pay for the project. Of that, \$2,048,400 is construction costs and the remainder includes engineering and other fees.

Alderman Bill McElhaney suggested that now would be a good time for residents to purchase water filtration
