Hoopeston Area gets small boost in six-day enrollment

Hoopeston Area enrollment got a slight boost over last vear's official number.

The six-day enrollment, used as the base figure for student aide, was up 31 students, to 1,279, said Supt. Hank Hornbeck at Thursday's school board meeting.

Last year, the official enrollment showed a drop of 57, to 1,248.

This year's enrollment shows 926 students in grade schools, excluding 40 CARE students and 353 in the high school, excluding 38 Rossville-Alvin students because R-A gets student aid for those, Hornbeck said.

In other action, the board approved the 2013-14 Ad-

ministrative Salary Compensation report, which shows salaries, retirement and health/life insurance paid.

Hornbeck tops the list with a salary of \$115,411. The district pays \$11,974.24 for his retirement.

Other administrators' compensation include: Larry Maynard, \$89,656, with \$9,302.08 in retirement; Linda Sheppard, \$85,515/\$8,872.44; Lori Eells, \$77,146/\$8,004.13; and Anne Burton and Dan Walder, \$70,082 salary, \$7,271.22 retirement.

- The district pays \$6,552 towards each administrator's health insurance and \$38.40 toward life insurance for each.
- In unrelated business, the board:
- Approved estimated total property taxes to be levied at \$3,150,500, a 9.18 percent increase over last year.
- Approved the 2014 budget.
- Approved hiring Ron Cade as sixth grade boys basket-ball coach for the 2013-14 year.
- Approved Nikki Pruemer's resignation as girls track coach, effective September 12.
- Heard a presentation from Karla Coon, director of the DACC Higher Learning Center. Coon reported the center has just under 80 students currently attending classes. Spring 2014 class offerings are currently being decided.
