Family, friends to hold benefit 'fore' man battling cancer

Jeremiah Silver loves to golf.

Family and friends who also love to golf are asking local people to help Silver in his battle against testicular cancer.

The 28-year-old Rossville man was diagnosed with cancer in June. The cancer was removed, but Silver learned it had spread to his abdomen, with lesions on his lungs, said his sister, Jenna Leslie.

Silver underwent chemotherapy treatment, which ended just last week. He will have a scan done on October 11 and find out the results on October 15. Leslie said her brother is not in remission, just waiting for re-

sults.

Cancer has taken a physical toll on Silver, who is currently unable to work. Meanwhile, medical bills are mounting.

To help him, family and friends will hold a benefit beginning at 1 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 5, at Hubbard Trail Country Club, 13937 E 3680 North Rd, Hoopeston .




