Vermilion County Health Department will hold an adult flu clinic at Hoopeston Multi Agency from 1-2 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 5. The Multi Agency is at 206 S. First Ave.

Cost for those 19 and older, at the clinic will be \$30. The health department will bill Medicare, Medicaid and all Health Alliance plans for adult flu shots. Individuals should be prepared to present proof of these types of coverage at the time of vaccination. The health department cannot bill private insurers, but a receipt can be provided to those who may be covered by insurance and want to seek reimbursement.
