New structure to nurture HA ag students' green thumbs


Hoopeston Area High School ag students have a place to nurture their green thumb efforts.

A 25' x 48' greenhouse was unveiled at an open house on October 28. Constructed on the southeast side of the high school, the greenhouse has heating and cooling systems, louvers to allow air flow from the outside and other amenities. The structure cost about \$65,000 from International Greenhouse of Tilton.

The cost will be repaid by the FFA, said Emily McCray, HAHS ag teacher/FFA advisor. The group made a \$25,000 payment in May and have agreed to pay \$10,000 per year for four years. Payments will come from the annual FFA tractor pull in Rossville, and from selling plants, including ferns, spider plants, annual bedding plants, flowers and some vegetable plants, including tomatoes and peppers, McCray said.

Plants will be stored on 18 4'x8' benches, built by the school's shop students and finished just in time for the open house. "We wouldn't have gotten ready for the open house without (Shawn) Swartzentruber's class," McCray said, adding ag and shop students worked together for about a week to get ready for the event.
