Storms that devastated central Illinois on Sunday caused minimal damage locally, but the inconvenience

caused by the storm lingered into Monday.

Two Illinois communities - Gifford and Washington - suffered catastrophic damage. Illinois National Guard personnel were sent to Washington to search for survivors amid the wreckage. Three deaths were linked to the storm in and around Washington.

Several homes were reported damaged in southern Vermilion County, especially in Belgium, while locally, Hoopeston police received reports of damaged sheds and power poles and downed trees in

tne area.

Much of Vermilion County was without power for

hours on Sunday afternoon. In Hoopeston, most power was restored shortly before dark.

Frontier telephone service was knocked out by cut cables. Cables were cut and in Gifford, the central office was damaged by a falling tree, which allowed rain to fall on sensitive phone equipment.

The phone outage affected Fron-

tier internet customers, who remained without service Monday.
