Hoopeston Area board approves band trip to Atlanta game

Members of the Hoopeston Area Marching Cornjerkers will get a short break from winter's cold next year when they go to a bowl game in Atlanta.

At Thursday night's meeting, the Hoopeston Area School Board unanimously approved allowing the band to go on the trip, which will cost about \$650 per student, including meals and other expenses, said Superintendent Hank Hornbeck.

Band director Patrick Brooks made the request at the November meeting, telling the board that 10-12 chaperones will accompany students and that two buses will be needed to accommodate those going and equipment.

In other discussion, Hornbeck told the board about recent ALICE training that four administrators recently participated in Champaign.

Alert Lockdown Inform Counter Evacuate provides training on what to do when an armed intruder is in a school. Currently, teachers are to make sure the classroom door is locked, turn off the lights and have students hide under desks or computer tables.

However, Hornbeck said, ALICE trainers said that is not always the best way to deal with such a scenario, as local administrators learned when they participated in the training based on the shooting incident at Colum-

bine, Colo., including 911 calls. "Your emotions were whirling the entire time," Hornbeck said.

The gist of the training is to "empower teachers to take other action, he said. For example, he said, students could have students escape the situation from a classroom window.

During the training, participants learned of a recent school shooting in Colorado. "That kind of hit home." Hornbeck said.

With 16 hours of training under the belts, administrators are now certified to train others in the district on the ALICE program.

In other business, the board:

• Approved creating the position of district webmaster. The job description for the position is expected to be voted on at the January 16,2014 meeting. The board also approved creating a position of middle school dean of students/athletic director. That job description is also expected to be approved next month.

• Approved requesting calendar waivers for Martin Luther King Day, Abraham Lincoln's birthday, Pulaski Day, Columbus Day and Veterans Day. Hornbeck said waivers should be good forever unless something
