To fill out the FAFSA parents and students will need:

- Social Security number. Be sure it is correct!
- Records of income, such as income earned from work and business, child support paid or received and any other untaxed income. If you have them, refer to the W-2 forms or information about assets, such as savings, certificates of deposit, stock options, bonds, 529 plans and other college savings programs; and investment real estate, business and farm.
- Federal Income Tax Return IRS 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ.
- Driver's license number, if you have one.
- Dates of birth, include the month, day and year.
- Month and year of marriage, separation, divorce or other change in marital status.
- Alien Registration Number, if student is not a U.S.
