



suggestions springing from the plan, so that it doesn't languish like a similar plan did in 2007.

Funding will come from the city's Tax Increment Financing (TIF) fund and is contingent upon city attorney approval of the contract.

In other business, the council heard from Mike Streff, of Foth Infrastructure and Environment, regarding changes in construction documents with Leader Construction for work on the city's water storage tanks. The contingency fund estimate of \$12,064 was overestimated, while aeration treatment was underestimated at \$7,941. Hoopeston will receive a \$4,623 credit in the contract.

Aldermen approved the bid correction and are expected to approve a change order at the January 21 meeting.
