Firefighters from Cissna Park, Buckley, East Lynn, Loda, Milford and Rankin were called to fire at about 8:40 a.m. The fire was extinguished by 1 p.m.

Smoke was reported coming from the north end of the bowling alley, with flames coming from the south end. A garage on the south end was engulfed in flames, according to reports. No injuries were reported.
