Carle Urbana and Hoopeston implement visitor guidelines

Due to increasing cases of flu, Carle Foundation Hospital and Carle Hoopeston Regional Health Center are implementing additional temporary visitor guidelines. For the safety of patients, visitors and staff, there will be a maximum of two visitors allowed in a patient's room at a time.

High risk areas in the hospital may implement additional visitor limitations. For instance, Carle Neonatal Intensive Care Unit is restricting visitors to parents, a maximum of two primary caregivers, and a maximum of four support persons. Also in NICU, visitors who are not the parents must be over 18 and must be healthy with no symptoms of cold, flu or other illness.
