Individual winners were Cassidy Dixon, first place, math in division and overall; Mason Jett, biology, second in division and third in division in physics; Andrew Samet, engineering graphics, first in division, third overall; Theresa Samet, English, second in division; and Matt Oyer, computer science, third in division.
