in creating a strategy for Hoopeston. A public meeting will be held at a later date, he said.

In January, Hoopeston signed an agreement with Champaign County Regional Planning to come up with a plan listing three objectives. Those objectives are to be given to city officials on or before June 30.

In other business, the council:

• Heard from Alderman Bill McElhaney about two recent water main breaks at the former Essex building on Route 1. McElhaney said the line will have to be fixed sooner rather than later.

• The council had previously discussed replacing the water main that runs from down Route 1 from Main Street south but has taken no action on it.

• Learned that Birkey's plans to replace their sign but that city ordinance says the sign may not be more than 15 feet tall. Thomas Sign & Awning Co., of Florida, will build the sign but will not erect it because of the ordinance. Mayor Bill Crusinberry said a variance is needed to allow the sign and referred the matter to the city plan commission.
