Police seek info on shooting, death at Downtown Motel

Police are looking for information in the shooting last night of a 40-year-old man. Police are withholding the man's identity, saying only that he was found in a room at the Downtown Motel, 200 E. Main.

Police were called to the motel at 9:03 p.m. Sunday for a report of shots fired. Officers found the body of the man in a room there, according to a police department press release.

An autopsy on the victim was expected to be done Monday.

According to the press release, the suspects fled on

foot, then in a vehicle.

Vermilion County Sheriff's Department is assisting with the investigation.


