### HPL Readers' Theatre to present 'Dawn's Early Light'

Hoopeston Public Library will present a Readers' Theatre program, "Dawn's Early Light," at 6 p.m. Tuesday, April 8.

The original dramatic production, written and directed by Tom Sweeney, recounts fictional stories of Hoopeston area history interspersed with a tribute to the 200th anniversary of the writing of "The Star Spangled Banner."

The story begins in 1814 along the Hubbard Trail, as settlers encounter difficulties in rescuing the American flag. The scene shifts to 1839 and the Red Pump Tavern, where north Vermilion men tell tall tales. The story then moves to the Civil War years, as Vermilion County soldiers pursue the flag in Tennessee.

Later, controversy swirls over naming the fledgling town of Hoopeston. In 1889, a star-crossed romance blossoms between two local teens. In 1914, as World War 1 looms, a farm mother bids farewell to her soldier son. Then, in 1939, an elderly couple mix up Hoopeston history in their senior moments. The Vietnam draft haunts two Cornjerker youth in the turbulent 1960s.

In 1989, an imagined portrait of a local beuty queen and her mother, who refuses to see her crowned, presents a tender moment. The drama concludes in the present by interweaving all the stories of the flag, national anthem and Hoopeston's colorful past.

"Local residents who have enjoyed our programs in the past will once gain be entertained by this imaginative story," said library Director Linda Mitchell.

Cast members include Mike Pemberton, Tom Cahan, Clint Mathewson, Tom Benjamin, Al Zawarus, Eric Layden, Denise Ried, April Jones, Yolanda Pemberton and Charlene Cessna. Janell Sechriest is the narrator.

The presentation is free and recommended for adult audiences only. Due to space limitations, tickets are

## **Danville Housing Authority to accept waitlist applications**

The Danville Housing Authority, Housing Choice Voucher Program Waitlist, will open at 9 a.m. Monday, March 31 and close at 4 p.m. Friday, April 4.

Applications may be picked up between those dates at Danville Housing Authority, 1607 Clyman Lane, Danville IL. Applications are also available on the housing authority website, www.danvilleha.org.

Completed applications must be returned no later than 4 p.m. April 4 with a copy of the valid state-issued photo ID for the head of household. Address on the ID must match address on the application.

Applications may be dropped off at the housing authority or mailed to DHA, P.O. Box 168, Danville IL 61834-0168, postmarked no later than April 4. Applications received or postmarked after April 4 will not be processed.

Completing an application does not entitle any person to a position on the waitlist.

To qualify for assistance, the applicant must:

• Be a family as defined in the Housing Agency's Administrative Plan. A copy of the Administrative Plan is posted or available at the housing agency office. You can be a family of one.
