### HA grad earns infantry honor

James (Kyle) Newton, a 2011 graduate of Hoopeston Area High School, recently earned the Expert Infantryman Badge (EIB).

A sergeant in the Old Guard, stationed at Fort Meyer in Washington DC., Newton took part in testing over a two-week period, where soldiers were graded on various tasks, such as weaponry, first aid, communications, land navigation, physical agility and techniques for movement under fire. The final day of testing resulted in a 12 mile ruck march that had to be completed in under three hours. Testing was both physically and mentally exhausting and had a pass rate of only 16 percent.

Sgt. Newton was one of only a handful to successfully complete the training and is now deemed an expert in the infantry. The badge he earned is exclusive to the infantry and one of the most sought after badges that an infantryman can earn.

Sgt. Newton is the son of Misti Bruens and Jim Newton of Hoopeston and is married to Aubrey (Trosper) formerly of Rossville.
