Baptist youth rummage sale targets archery equipment for camp

Some local youth are taking aim at helping an area camp improve its equipment.

First Baptist Church youth are holding a rummage sale Saturday at the Dave Johnson far, 12246 E 4200 North Rd., to raise money for archery equipment for Camp Assurance, outside of Georgetown. The camp has some equipment, but some needs to be upgraded and other equipment needs to be replaced.

Camp Assurance, which moved to its current location in 1949, is a nonprofit Baptist camp that gives kids a fun place to go, while preparing them for eternity. Kids learn that Jesus loves them enough to take
