Online petition seeks to stop tax hike from permanency

After what could prove to be the first in a long line of tax increase votes, State Rep. Josh Harms (R-Watseka) and fellow Republicans across the state have launched an online petition drive against efforts to make the Illinois temporary income tax increase of 2011 permanent. "Illinois needs to concentrate on job growth," said Rep. Harms. "Continuous tax raises do nothing but expand

government at the expense of our community's families."

On January 11, 2011, Illinois Democrats raised taxes by 67% during a lame duck session in what sponsors claimed would be a short-term solution to paying Illinois' bills. Three years later Illinois still carries over \$7

billion in unpaid bills while enduring the second highest unemployment rate in the country at 8.7%.

Earlier this legislative session, Republicans signed on to House Joint Resolution 80, unanimously supporting the FY 2015 revenue estimate of \$34.5 billion, placing Illinois in a position to allow the tax increase to expire. Despite this spending limit, Illinois Democrats have proceeded to introduce multiple tax proposals seeking to increase revenues beyond this spending authority.
