Street collection to help fund youth mission trip to Tampa

This coming Saturday the St. Anthony Youth group will be conducting a street corner drive to collect money in support of their annual mission trip in June.

"We have 27 students going this year, a record number" said Aaliyah Colunga. "This is my fourth year going. The experience renews me."

This year the trip will be to Tampa, Fla. The main focus of the trip is "service to others." The group will repair houses, work in homeless shelters, soup kitchens and help in children services. In addition they will have a social experience by participating in a camp with 300 other youth. Finally, it will be a spiritual experience,

beginning and ending each day in prayer.

"People ask why we go so far away," said chaperone Laura Warner. "We try hard to make it a cultural experience as well as a service and social experience. Hopefully, the students will see there is a big world out there so very different from Hoopeston."

"It costs a lot of money to take 28 kids so far away. We know that no matter how well we do on Saturday, we will have to dip into our reserves," said Bill Goodwine, another chaperone. "But, 28 students are a lot more than our usual number. We have several college


