Bismarck-Henning runs past Oakwood-Armstrong Potomac, Hoopeston Area in relays

Bismarck-Henning ran to an easy win over Oakwood-Armstrong Potomac and Hoopeston Area in the 45th annual Hobbs Relays Tuesday at Hoopeston Area.

The Blue Devils led in six of the 10 events, taking five points each in the long jump (64’ 11½”); high jump (19’6”), shot put 150’ 7”), sprint medley (2:07.36), 4x300 (3:14.67) and 4x100 (:53.67).

Oakwood led scoring in the discus (363’8”) distance medley (14:08.29 and middle distance (4:49.05).

Hoopeston took the top spot in the shuttle hurdle at 1:05.12.

For the event, Bismarck led with 40 points, followed by Oakwood with 34 and Hoopeston Area with 16.
