DACC extends deadline to May 22 for two new scholarships

DANVILLE – The DACC Foundation has announced two new scholarships have been established and will make their first awards for fall 2014. The application deadline has been extended to May 22 for the new scholarships.

The Alcoa Advanced Manufacturing Scholarship was established through a \$10,000 grant from the Alcoa

Foundation to promote opportunities in advanced manufacturing and to encourage students to enroll in this field of study. Funds will provide two \$5,000 scholarships that may be used towards the cost of tuition, fees or books. Scholarships will be spread over the two years necessary to complete an associate degree in advanced
