DACC announces commencement speaker, 2014 graduates

DANVILLE—Danville Area Community College will confer degrees and certificates during Commencement exercises at 7 p.m. Friday, May 16, in Mary Miller Gymnasium. Nearly 200 graduates will participate in this year's ceremony, while nearly 450 degrees and certificates will be conferred overall.

Lt. Col. (Dr.) David Tharp will deliver the Commencement address. He is an Oakwood-area native who works as a psychologist with the Veterans Integrated Service Network (VISN) 17 Center of Excellence for Research on Return War Veterans at the Waco VA hospital in Waco, TX.

Tharp, a 1985 graduate, was named the DACC Distinguished Alumnus for 2013.

During 2010-2011, Tharp voluntarily deployed to Kandahar, Afghanistan (KAF) to gain real-world experience and make a direct impact on the research into treatment of returning war veterans. In Kandahar, he suffered a spinal cord injury/disease process, transverse myelitis, yet chose to postpone treatment and remain in-theatre in order to complete his tour of duty.

Tharp was recently promoted to program manager for the residential PTSD program in Waco. Along with his VA responsibilities, he is stationed at the United States Air Force Academy where he educates airmen in psychological tactics of war, and is a psychologist for the Cadet Wing Peak Performance Center. He is also an Associate Professor at Texas A & M Health Science Center, College of Medicine. He lives in Texas with his wife and two young sons.

Delivering the Class Response will be Jolyn S. Silver, Rossville, summa cum laude candidate receiving an ASA degree in secondary mathematics education. Graduates of distinction will be recognized during the Commencement exercises. Students who have a cumulative grade-point average of 4.000 will graduate with the designation summa cum laude and will wear a gold tassel, gold cord, and a medallion; those with a cumulative grade-point average of 3.750-3.999 will graduate with the designation magna cum laude and will wear a gold tassel and a gold cord; and those with a cumulative grade-point average of 3.50-3.749 will graduate with the designation cum laude and will wear a gold tassel.

Students' ability to be recognized at the graduation ceremony is based on the cumulative grade-point average calculated at the end of the fall semester prior to the spring ceremony.
