Hoopeston will honor those who died in service to their country at the annual Memorial Day service Monday.

The service will begin at 10:30 a.m. at Floral Hill Cemetery Chapel. Participating will be the American Legion and VFW Color Guard, along with Hoopeston Area Band, directed by Patrick Brooks, and Hoopeston Area Chorus, directed by Rochelle Morgeson.

Following a welcome from Mayor Bill Crusinberry, Pastor Bruce McQuigg, of New Beginnings Church, will give the opening prayer, which will be followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Following the National Anthem, the Rev. Brian Manigold, chaplain at the Danville Veterans Affairs Medical Center, will give the keynote address.

Members of all branches of the armed forces who are in attendance will be recognized as the "Armed Forces Melody" is played. After veterans come forward for recognition, closing remarks will be made and the benediction given.

Ending the service will be 30 seconds of silence for those who gave their lives for the freedom of our country, the firing squad Salute to the Dead and the playing
