

Lesson leads to experiment, fundraiser for Malawi youth

On Friday May 9, Clinton Mathewson's freshmen geography class put on a "Hat Day" to raise money and awareness for the children of Malawi. More than \$325 was raised to help get students off of dirt floors and into desks.

After students saw what it was like for children in Malawi, they wanted to experience what it was like to "walk in their shoes". During a class period, students learned like Malawi children, sitting on the floor and taking verbal notes without the assistance of any technology. Students then reflected on their experience.

"Uncomfortable," "cramped," and "distracting" were some words students used to describe it.

Afterward, students felt no child should have to learn in this manner so they created the fundraiser. Not only was the class able to raise enough money to help purchase desks for the children of Malawi but, in a country where only seven percent of girls have a high school education, students were able to pay tuition for a girl to go to school.

All of the money raised will go to the UNICEF-K.I.N.D.


