USDA Rural Development to hold informational forum here

CHAMPAIGN—USDA Rural Development (RD) will highlight National Homeownership Month in June, with events in Illinois and across the nation. In FY2014 and among the 47 state RD offices, Illinois currently ranks first in assisting eligible homeowners with critical repairs, third in providing grants and seventh in direct homeownership loans.

An informational forum to help real estate professionals and the general public better understand the availability and benefits of Rural Development housing programs, including 100% financing, has been scheduled for 10:30 a.m. Thursday, June26 at Hoopeston City Hall.
