# Bright Smiles offers free kids' dental screenings Thursday

DANVILLE—Hoopeston youngsters will be urged to smile today, but not for a new photograph. Instead, they may receive free dental screenings from 9:30-11:30 a.m. Thursday at McFerren Park.

HALO Project, a healthy community initiative sponsored by Presence United Samaritans Medical Center's Foundation, in partnership with Colgate-Bright Smiles Bright Futures and Orland Park Dental Services, will host "Smiling Faces Dental Days" June 26-27.

Children ages 3–18 will receive a free dental screening as well as a goody bag with dental supplies to use for proper oral hygiene at home. Parents/ guardians must accompany children.

Other stops for the Colgate-Bright Smiles Bright Futures Dental Van include:

9:30-11:30 am - Westville - St. Mary's Church 1-4 pm - Danville - Vermilion Garden Apartments

Children and their parent/guardian from all cities and towns in Vermilion County are welcome at any of the four sites. Services are provided on a "first come first served" basis.



The dental screening will satisfy all Vermilion County school districts' dental screening requirement for children in kindergarten, second, and sixth grades. Forms will be completed and given to the parent/guardian at the time of the screening.

Colgate-Bright Smiles Bright Futures will provide the dental van, supplies, and goody bags, while Orland Park Dental Services will provide the dentist and hygienist who will be completing the dental screenings.

"Dental health is directly related to other overall health, and there is now medical proof that gum disease is directly linked to developing cardiovascular disease," said Kathy Richard, HALO Project director. "It is extremely important that children receive appropriate dental care and that they are taught how to properly take care of their teeth now in order to avoid the risk of disease later in life."

Many Vermilion County children do not have access to or cannot afford dental care. Many families admit not having enough dental supplies for each member of their family to practice healthy oral hygiene.
