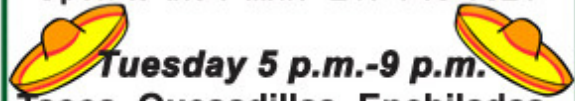

Shop, rock and roll at 12 hour Lorraine street party Saturday

Things will be hoppin' at the Lorraine Theatre on Saturday—and rockin' and rollin', too.

Save the Lorraine Foundation is holding a street party from noon to midnight Saturday, July 19, with activities inside and outside of the Lorraine Theatre, at 324 E. Main.

Food will be offered throughout the event. Three food vendors will have "something for everyone," Houmes said.

In addition, local groups will get in on the act, with Hoopeston Rotary serving ice cream; a Mom & Pop's Kettle Korn Stop; and Mr. B's will be open for lunch, while serving snow cones and slushies outside.

Concessions, cupcakes and refreshments will be served out of the Lorraine Theatre lobby, as well.

Vendors will also be on hand, offering a variety of items. Some vendors include Brownie Bands, offering scarves, headbands, and miscellaneous items; A Unique Touch, with vintage and repurposed items; Thirty One totes and bags; Plexus weight loss and nutrition; Scentsy candles; Tastefully Simple spices and dips; Adalay Photography; Hoopeston Health and Fitness; Connie Catron, with custom bottle cap necklaces; Robinson Chiro-

practic; The Pink Poodle; Mary Kay Cosmetics; Sewing Boutique; Farmhouse Chic, with furniture and repurposed items; and Al Carl with glassware, décor, knives, bikes and tools.

Kids activities will be held from 1-4 p.m. Hoopeston Junior Women's Club will hold a kits carnival with a variety of activities and games with prizes.

From 3-4 p.m., Anderson Funeral Home is sponsoring a kiddy tractor pull. Parents may sign up their children right before the event starts.

Carle Arrow Ambulance Service will be on hand to let kids explore an ambulance and learn what it takes to be an emergency medical technician and Hoopeston Fire Department will have their ladder truck set up for youngsters to see.

From noon-4 p.m., a silent auction will be held in the Lorraine foyer. Items have been donated by the community and local businesses.

Musical will begin at 5 p.m. Six bands will play until midnight on a stage at the intersection of Main and Third St. Bands include Tongue & Groove (rock & roll) at 5 p.m.; Dirt (90s rock) at 6 p.m.; and Rikki Rokstarr (hard rock) at 7. Another hard rock band, Eclipse, kicks off the 8 o'clock hour followed at 9 p.m. by New Day Burning (indie rock); Klematis Project (Dubstep/DJ/Remix) at 10 p.m.; and for the final hour, AiraCobra (heavy metal).

Alcohol will be provided by Hoopeston Jaycees from 8-11:45 p.m. Beers and mixed drinks will be offered from a beer wagon north of the stage on Third St. An area will be roped off for people 21 or older who purchase alcohol and all alcoholic beverages must stay in the special area, Houmes said.
