Social Security to continue to provide benefit verification letters until further notice

Last week, the Social Security Administration announced local Social Security offices would continue to provide benefit verification letters until further notice. Providing services when and where the public needs them remains central to Social Security's efforts, while continuing to encourage federal, state, and local agencies to take advantage of Social Security's data exchange programs that can serve customers more efficiently and effectively.

"We appreciate the feedback from members of Congress, our community stakeholders and agency partners," said acting Commissioner Carolyn W. Colvin. "We want to ensure that we meet the needs of our customers in a way that is convenient for them and also cost-effective and secure for all. I believe that government agencies can work closer together to assist our mutual customers."

Over the last few years, Social Security has invested in technology that allows most government agencies and many other organizations to verify their clients' Social Security benefits electronically without requiring them to visit a local Social Security office.

"We recognize that some members of the public may

require in-person assistance and we will have a presence in local communities," said Colvin said. "We also want to ensure that the public is aware that they can access many of our services without making a trip to a local

field office."

Members of the public with Internet access can obtain benefit verification information by creating a my Social Security account at www.socialsecurity.gov/myaccount.
