Street party helped Lorraine renovations, businesses, too

The July 19 Lorraine Street Party raised money for repairs at the theater and also put some money into the coffers of local businesses.

Through donations, 50/50 drawings and sales, Save the Lorraine Foundation received more than \$8,000, which will be used for renovations, said party organizer Alex Houmes.

Additionally, the crowd - estimated at about 2,000 people - strained the supplies of food vendors, who had to make trips to Jerry's IGA to stock up. The delay made for some long lines to eat, but party-goers didn't seem to mind, joking and visiting with others in line.

Visitors also made use of Hoopeston restaurants and gas stations during the event, he said. "I think we were able to boost local businesses a bit," he said.

Many people with a connection to the Lorraine came from out-of-town. Houmes talked to a woman who was a theater usher in the early 1940s. She was too young to

be on the payroll, so she accepted ice cream sundaes from The Ritz as payment, he said. She even remembered the marquee being installed.

One comment Houmes heard many times the day of the event was that the party provided the most activity many of them had seen downtown in a long time. "We were very pleased with this," he said. "One goal of re-opening the theater is to bring traffic back to downtown."

While Houmes was the point man for the party, he credits local people and businesses with making it a success.
