All applicants must bring proof of income for the past 30 days, Social Security numbers for everyone in the household, and medical card for each family member, if receiving public assistance through the Department of Human Services.

School supplies will be dispensed on:

- Tuesday, Aug. 12—Maple Grade School
- Wednesday, Aug. 13—Honeywell Grade School
- Thursday, Aug. 14—John Greer Grade School.

If any child missed registration, you are welcome to apply for school supplies after August 15.

All information must be present when applying or the application cannot be processed.

Arrested woman cleared when second woman admits wreck

Owners of Centennial, Sesquicentennial farms still have chance to be featured in book

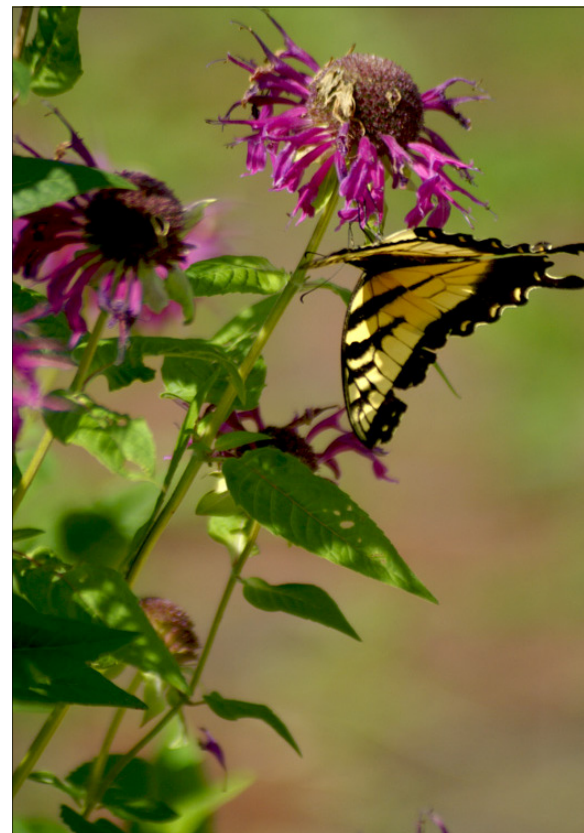
Owners of Illinois Department of Agriculture Centennial or Sesquicentennial Award-winning farms who haven't submitted their farm histories and photos for inclusion in the IDOA's upcoming book will have one last opportunity to send in their submissions, according to the book's publisher.

The coffee-table book *Illinois Historic Farms: Honoring the State's Enduring Heritage of Family-Owned Farms* will feature histories of family-owned farms that have been certified by the Illinois Department of Agriculture as Centennial or Sesquicentennial Farms, as well as photos and stories documenting the history of agricul-

ture in the state.

Editor Charles Francis of Acclaim Press said that the work of compiling, editing and prepping for publication thousands of submissions received so far is well under-way. While that work is going on, he said, the publisher has decided to continue to allow late submissions for the book until the final deadline of Sept. 30.

While a few Centennial and Sesquicentennial farm owners may not have sent in their stories and photos due

to procrastination, Francis said that the publisher is still getting calls from farmers who never received a promotional mailing and have just recently heard about the project by word of mouth or from news stories.

"Even though we have mailed and distributed about 15,000 brochures in the last nine months, a lot of them that haven't gotten to the right address or the right person," Francis said. "Once farmers learn about the project, the level of enthusiasm for it has been overwhelming. We don't want an eligible farm to be omitted from the book just because they never got a mailing."

Francis said a final round of brochure mailings will be going out the first week of August. Farm owners who don't get a brochure by Aug. 8 should call Acclaim Press at 877-427-2665 to request a brochure, which contains all the details about book submissions and how to reserve copies of the book at the special advance order price of \$49.95.

Visitors to the Illinois State Fair in Springfield will be able to pick up a brochure on August 12 at the Director's Lawn during the Agriculture Day festivities.
