"It" is the Hoopeston Multi Agency's new 2014 Elkhart van, delivered Monday from Midwest Transit in Kankakee.

The van replaces a 2006 model and has improved equipment that will make loading and unloading passengers quicker and easier.

The wheelchair lift works more quickly than the old one. Van driver James "Fuzzy" Goodrum said it will be a hit with many passengers. For some riders, walking up the steps to take a seat is difficult, so they board via the lift. "They're going to love this," Goodrum said, taking a

Backup cameras and beepers that sound when the van is backing are also on the new model. Unlike the 2006 diesel van, the new one is gasoline-driven.

Acting director Chalmers Flint said diesel would be better if the van was going to be used for out-of-town trips, but for its mostly in-town excursions, gas was the way to go.

Choosing a gas-driven bus saved the agency some money, too. At \$50,253, the van is about \$6,000 less than its diesel counterpart.

Much of the cost of the van will be paid by grants and donations.

The Multi Agency van runs Monday through Friday and takes seniors and disabled people to stops throughout Hoopeston, including doctors' appointments, shopping and others.


