Watseka man arrested in connection with Friday shooting

A 29-year-old Watseka man was arrested in connection with a shooting at 2:25 a.m. Friday in the 500 block of East Seminary.

Tyler J. Henady was arrested on preliminary charges of aggravated discharge of a firearm-person and possession of a weapon by a felon, said Hoopeston Police Chief Mark Drollinger.

According to a press release issued by Drollinger, police were called to the scene and found an unidentified 33-year-old Hoopeston man lying on the ground, saying he had been shot by a person he knew. The victim provided information on the alleged shooter and the vehicle.

The victim thought he had been shot but was found not to be injured, according to the press released.

An officer located the vehicle on Route 1, entering Iroquois County, and stopped the vehicle. Henady was taken into custody without incident and was taken to the Iroquois County Jail. A Vermilion County warrant was issued on the charges and Henady was extradited. He is being held on \$75,000 bond.


Drollinger declined to comment on the caliber of firearm used but confirmed it was a handgun. A motive for the shooting is still under investigation.
