## Budget reflects worst case, but has positive cash balances

If the bottom falls out of financing for Hoopeston Area district, a proposed budget will get it through the year.

Business manager Mark Eighner proposed a budget at Thursday evening's school board meeting that shows negative balances in six of eight district funds.

In the education fund, used to pay most of the cost of education students, the district expects income of \$10,463,000, from local property taxes, state aid and payments for federal programs, such as Title 1.

Education fund expenses for the year are estimated at \$11,231,582, a deficit of \$768,582.

Other funds with projected deficits under the "worst

case scenario" budget are the building fund, with income of \$304,000 and expenses of \$1,015,000 (-\$771,000); transportation, income \$426,000, expenses \$498,820 (-72,820); municipal retirement \$258,000 revenue and \$462,072 (-204,072); tort income of \$233,200, expenses \$261,000 (-27,800); and life safety, \$30,200 revenue and expenses, \$160,000, (-129,800).

The working cash fund has projected income of \$32,000 and no expenses and the bond and interest fund has no income or expenses.

Despite projected losses between revenue and expenses, projected cash balances for all funds are expected to be in the black, with the education fund projected to end the year with a cash balance of \$4,588,418, up slightly from the actual cash balance of \$5,357,000 at the end of the 2014 fiscal year.

Other projected cash balances are: building, \$139,000; transportation, \$65,180; municipal retirement, \$611,928; working cash, \$1,775,000; tort, \$71,200; life safety, \$6,200; and bond and interest, \$4,000.

The proposed budget, is on display in the district office and is expected to be approved at the September 19 meeting.
