Leaders seek citizen input at community meeting Wednesday

Do you have an opinion about what Hoopeston needs to thrive?

If so, community leaders hope you'll attend a meeting from 6-8 p.m. Wednesday at the Hoopeston American Legion, 502 E. Penn.

Sponsored by the newly-formed Hoopeston Community Alliance, the meeting will focus on the results of the strategic planning process that began in March, when leaders met to determine potential areas that might be addressed.

On April 14, about 100 citizens met to review the list and prioritize goals in major categories, including housing, infrastructure, education and business, among others.

The citizens' choices were reviewed by community leaders and the information has been organized to be presented at Wednesday's meeting.

"We want input from the community," said Karla Coon, a driving force behind Hoopeston Community Alliance. "We want to know what they think is going well. We want to hear their ideas for continued improvements and ways to build upon the good things already in motion."

The goal of the alliance's work is to position Hoopeston for growth, moving forward. To accomplish that, community volunteers are needed to help accomplish the goals that have been set under each of the seven areas.

At the meeting, residents will be asked to become part of the alliance so ALL can work together to build Hoopeston's future.

Attendees will be asked to complete a volunteer questionnaire. answering questions such as how much time they are willing to dedicate to working on projects in one of seven areas. Those areas and their leaders are:


