Election packets available next week to local candidates

People interested in running for local governing bodies may start circulating nominating petitions next week for the April 7, 2015 consolidated election.

Candidate petitions for Hoopeston and Rossville municipal boards and Hoopeston Area school board will be available starting Monday. Candidates may begin circulating petitions Tuesday. Petitions are to be filed with the county clerk from December 15-22.

In Hoopeston, one four-year term in each of the wards is up for election. Incumbents for those seats are Joe Fell in Ward 1, Randy Carter in Ward 2, Nancy Stipp in Ward 3 and Brandon Hamilton in Ward 4.

Petitions are available at Hoopeston City Hall and are may be picked up from 7 a.m.-noon and 1-4 p.m. Monday-Friday.

In Rossville, voters will select three trustees for four-year terms and one for a two-year term. Incumbents are
