Hoopeston Area grade/middle school enrollment declines

Hoopeston Area schools saw a decline in enrollment between the sixth day of the 2013-14 school year and this year.

Six day enrollment figures - the number used to determine state aid for the district - were released at Thursday's district board meeting.

Hoopeston Area had 1,237 students on the sixth day of school, down from 1,279 last year.

The number does not include 31 Rossville-Alvin high school students, because R-A receives state aid for their students, then pays tuition for them to attend Hoopeston Area, or 15 CARE students, which are funded through a federal title program.

The loss was all at the grade/middle school level, with an enrollment of 883, down from 926 last year.

Hoopeston Area High School enrollment - at 354 this year - actually increased by one student.

Superintendent Hank Hornbeck said the district is examining the numbers to find out where those students went. "Any time you lose that many, it concerns you," he said.

This year's decrease is the third biggest in the past 10 years. The largest was in 2005-06, with a 60-student drop, followed in 2012-13, with a loss of 57

students.

In other business, the board approved an estimated tax levy of \$3,131,000, up 8.2 percent from last year's \$2,893,000.

Business manager Mark Eighner said the levy increase is to cover the possibility of property values going up. For example, had the district approved a five percent increase and equalized assessed valuation rose by eight percent, the district would have lost three percent of available funding. "We just didn't want to leave anything on the table," Eighner said.

While the approved levy is higher, the tax rate is not expected to increase but to remain in the \$4.64 area it has been at for several years, Eighner said.

- Heard from Dan Walder, John Greer principal, that the Chromebook pilot program has gone well. "I've heard no complaints," he said, calling the integration "seamless." Walder read excerpts from teacher emails, praising the program.
- Approved the immediate resignation of Jake Mott, freshman boys basketball coach; and the September 8 resignation of Jamie Pruitt, Honeywell third grade teacher.
- Approved Lupe Martinez' retirement as janitor, effective October 1.
- Approved volunteers Henry Patton, high school wrestling; and Brenda Herman at John Greer, effective immediately.
- Approved hiring, effective September 19, Devin McFadden, high school JV volleyball coach; Tina Ailey, Honeywell third grade teacher; and Cathy Uden, part time custodian.
- Approved hiring, effective September 15, Susan Goble, high school personal aide; and Linda Walsh, custodian.


