Students will be able to take a paws to read at Maple

Maple Grade School students will soon have a new reading buddy.

Grant, eight-year-old German shepherd owned by learning disabilities resource teacher Carolyn Daniel, will soon listen to youngsters as they read.

Daniel and Grant were at last week's Hoopeston Area School Board meeting to talk about the program.

Grant will attend Maple School two days a week and will hang out in Daniel's room. The goal is to have youngsters improve their reading skills and increase their confidence by reading to Grant. "He's not going to correct them if they say something wrong," Daniel said.

Research indicates that dogs help achieve those goals, Daniel said, adding she plans to test students before Grant comes and compare those scores with those after students have read to him during the year.

Grant's work isn't expected to start until November. Between now and then, Daniel plans to contact parents about students with dog allergies. She will also begin working with students on how to approach Grant - or any dog - in a safe manner.

Grant has proved himself worthy in many areas. He is trained in Schutzhund, a training system/sport for working dogs that focuses on tracking, obedience and protection. Grant was named Schutzhund regional champion and has since retired from the program.

Not one to rest on his laurels, in June, Grant was assessed for work as a therapy dog. Now

Grant wears a neckerchief, indicating he is a therapy dog. As such, Daniel may take him to the local nursing home, hospital, VA and Carle Pavilion. "He's a very social dog for a German shepherd," she said.

While some therapy dogs provide physical assistance, Grant "is not a physical therapist," Daniel said. "He's more of an emotional therapist.

Principal Lori Eells said the program will be a hit with students. "We think the kids are going to be really excited about reading with him," she said.
