Sheriff's department, DEA offer Take Back drug disposal

DANVILLE—On September 27, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., the Vermilion County Sheriff's Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) will give the public an opportunity to dispose of potentially dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs at a Take Back event.



Bring pills or patches for disposal to the Vermilion County Courthouse, 7 North Vermilion St., Danville. The DEA cannot accept liquids or needles or sharps, only pills or patches. The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked.

Last April, Americans turned in 390 tons (more than

780,000 pounds) of prescription drugs at nearly 6,100 sites operated by the DEA and more than 4,400 of its state and local law enforcement partners. When those results are combined with what was collected in its eight previous Take Back events, DEA and its partners have taken in over 4.1 million pounds - more than 2,100 tons - of pills.

This initiative addresses a public safety and public health issue. Medicines that languish in home cabinets are highly susceptible to diversion, misuse, and abuse. Rates of prescription drug abuse in the U.S. are high, as

Flu shots
 Carle Hoopeston Regional Health Center will have a flu shot clinic at Charlotte Ann Russell Medical Center, 801 E. Orange, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. September 29. Flu shots will be available for those six months and older; Pneumovax will be available to adults only.
 No appointment is necessary. Carle Physician Group patients may choose direct billing and must bring their clinic number and insurance card to do so. Medicare patients must bring their Medicare cards for direct billing.
 Non-Medicare or non-Carle Physician Group patients should be prepared to pay at the time of service. Seasonal flu shots cost \$40, high-dose flu shots

 are the number of accidental poisonings and overdoses due to these drugs. Studies show that a majority of abused prescription drugs are obtained from family and friends, including from the home medicine cabinet. In addition, Americans are now advised that their usual methods for disposing of unused medicines - flushing them down the toilet or throwing them in the trash - both pose potential safety and health hazards.
 DEA is in the process of approving new regulations that implement the Safe and Responsible Drug Disposal Act of 2010, which amends the Controlled Substances Act to allow an “ultimate user” (that is, a patient or their family member or pet owner) of controlled substance medications to dispose of them by delivering them to entities authorized by the Attorney General to accept them. The act also allows the Attorney General to authorize long term care facilities to dispose of their residents’ controlled substances in certain instances.
