Mayor asks residents to support sales tax increase Nov. 4

Mayor Bill Crusinberry is asking residents to support a referendum on the November 4 ballot that, if approved, will increase sales tax by one percent.

Money raised from the increase will be used for a "pretty progressive" program to address infrastructure needs and dilapidated houses.

"There are easily 20 abandoned houses," Crusinberry said. "If we let them stand there, they're going to stand there until they fall down."

Additionally, money from the tax would allow improvements in the city, including fixing park roads, which Crusinberry said are "terrible," and the "rough"

sidewalks at Northside (Cheese) Park, along with fixing things, like the tennis courts.

Infrastructure improvements are expensive, Crusinberry said, citing water tower improvements, which will be paid off over 20 years. He also cited the need for newer infrastructure, replacing water mains that were installed in 1888.

"I think we need to make this a better town," he said, adding that the increase would add 25 cents to the cost of a \$25 dinner.
