Library to showcase 'Time and Hoopeston Houses, 1923'

Hoopeston Public Library will present "Time and Hoopeston Houses, 1923," an original production written and directed by Thomas Sweeney, at 7 p.m. Tuesday.

The local historical drama recounts events occurring in six Hoopeston homes, 1923. Guests will also enjoy learning about the charming interiors of homes during this period.

The performance is free but it is recommended that patrons pick up advanced tickets at the library's main desk. The presentation is recommended for adult audience only.

Narrator Janell Siechriest invites a paperhanger (Yolanda Pemperton) and a house painter (Mike Pemperton) to help present episodes about those who live in the homes.

Episodes include Mary Scott, Tom Hoopes' niece, and her granddaughter, Jesse Trent (Maggie Cope), who live in the Hoopes-Cunningham home. Scott Hudson is Dr. Russell, who encounters an unusual citizen (Tom Benjamin) in an intense medical Hoopeston dilemma.
