Hoopeston Public Library will present "Time and Hoopeston Houses, 1923," an original production written and directed by Thomas Sweeney, at 7 p.m. Tuesday.

The local historical drama recounts events occurring in six Hoopeston homes, 1923. Guests will also enjoy learning about the charming interiors of homes during this period.

The performance is free but it is recommended that patrons pick up advanced tickets at the library's main desk. The presentation is recommended for adult audience only.

Narrator Janell Siechriest invites a paperhanger (Yolanda Pempberton) and a house painter (Mike Pemberton) to help present episodes about those who live in the homes.




