Hoopeston Area schools to host Veterans Day program

Hoopeston Area schools will host local veterans and guests at its annual Veterans Day ceremony.

The event will begin at 9:30 a.m. Tuesday in the Hoopeston Area Middle School gym with a welcome from high school principal Larry Maynard. Presentation of the colors will be done by Hoopeston Area VFW and American Legion, followed by playing of the "Star Spangled Banner" by Hoopeston Area High School band.

Following a student essay, the band will perform "Banners on Parade" and the keynote address given by Fred Tabor. All veterans present will be recognized, with an introduction by Mayor Bill Crusinberry.

More music is on tap with "A Salute to American Heroes" and "Star Spangled Banner Finale" performed by the high school band and chorus.

After 30 seconds of silence, the Placement of the Helmet will be done in memory of soldiers lost, followed by "Taps," performed by band members, and retiring the colors.

Following the ceremony, everyone is invited to Hoopeston American Legion, 502 E. Penn, for free chili and potato soup.
